- Support companies forming value chains across the Nordic borders

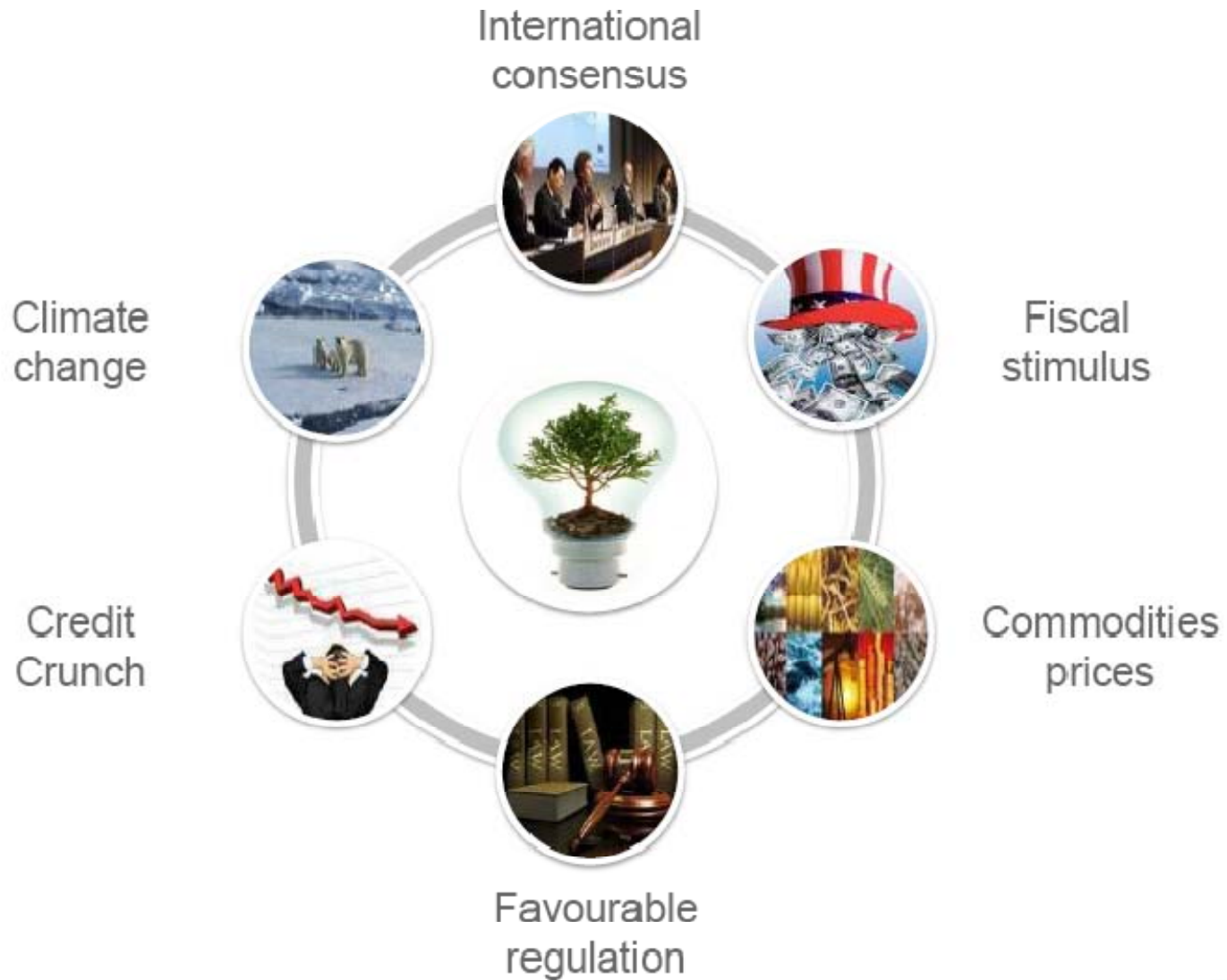


Promoting Nordic cleantech solutions
